
WAUKESHA PUBLIC LIBRARY 2006 ANNUAL REPORT

EXPANDED SERVICES

- ♦ "Bookleggers": a new cooperative venture with the School District of Waukesha was made possible by a grant from the Waukesha Kiwanis Club.
- ♦ "Bookletters": our book review newsletter is now offered in an enhanced electronic format.
- Expanded Computer Classes: 37 classes were offered in 2006, including one designed especially for customers with hearing disabilities.
- Teen Zone Events & Programs: featured live music by Hayward Williams, award-winning author Chris Crutcher during 'Stories Jubilee', and the popular Milwaukee Bucks 'Read To Achieve' project.
- Outreach Success: a record breaking 5,000 visits were made to community members who are homebound or in health care facilities.
- Movie Programming: a new agreement with 'Movies Licensing USA' made it possible for the Library to present diverse feature films.

TECHNOLOGY

- Free Hot Spot: wireless access at the library was initiated. WI-FI is very popular and here to stay!
- SelfCheck Technology: usage continues to grow. Customers checked out 68% of their in-house materials via the Library's five self-service machines.
